## MARGATE HARBOUR ARM

The historic Margate Harbour Arm has been given a facelift. Through a collaboration between Margate Harbour Arm Ltd., the European Development fund and Thanet District Council, Margate Harbour Arm has been refurbished to create spaces for an art gallery, artists studios, retail outlets, a cafe and a bar/restaurant. The lighting scheme enhances the improvements of the Harbour Arm at night and are developed from concepts originally set out in the Margate Seafront Lighting Strategy.

There are four different elements to the lighting scheme which concentrate on different aspects of the Harbour. The Lighthouse and the Droit House at the opposite ends, are lit to frame the view of the colour changing scheme on the Harbour Arm. Handrails have been designed to work in marine environment and they provide additional safety and security to the upper level of the Harbour Arm, as well as to provide contrasting and additional lighting interest.

## Key facts and information

The main scheme centres on the Harbour Arm itself. The scheme is designed to be robust and requires in-frequent maintenance. The fittings are rated for underwater use and are designed to be robust and well engineered for permanent installation in a working marine environment. The use of LEDs with a long life makes for extremely low running costs and creates a dynamic, affordable scheme. The control system is designed to allow instructions to be sent via the internet or via mobile phone.
